

THE RINKS ANAHEIM ICE 3 ON 3 ADULT HOCKEY TOURNAMENT RULES



- 1. USA Hockey rules will apply except as noted herein.
- 2. CREDENTIALS REQUIRED: current year USA Hockey membership.
- 3. EQUIPMENT: All players participating in The Rinks Adult Hockey tournaments must wear protective equipment that meets USAH requirements.
- 4. TEAMS: six (6) players and one (1) goalie maximum per team.
- 5. DIVISIONS: Upper and Lower ages 18 and older. Maximum of Twelve (12) teams per division
- 6. GAMES:
 - Zero tolerance policy NO CHECKING. Any intentional, overt or reckless body contact will result in a minor or major penalty.
 - Penalties will be enforced:
 - MINOR penalties: penalty shot at end
 - MAJOR penalties will result in automatic ejection from game
 - MISCONDUCT penalties (fighting and other serious infractions) will result in automatic suspension from the tournament.
 - Fighting is strictly prohibited. Any player that fights will be ejected from the tournament without replacement.
 - Slap shots are not allowed. If the stick rises above the knee in attempt of a shot or pass, it will result in a change of puck possession.
 - No off sides or icing. If called will result in a change of puck possession.
 - Scoring Format: two (2) points for WIN, one (1) point for TIE, zero (0) points for LOSS.
 - 8 goal mercy rule
 - Overtimes are sudden death 3 man shootouts
 - All teams play 3 round robin games and all teams make single elimination playoffs or guaranteed four (6) games
 - Tie Breaker: (A) Most wins, (B) Head to Head play between two tied teams (if 3 or more teams are tied, go to C, but if one of these teams has beaten every team that it is tied with, that team will advance to next available seed), (C) Goal Differential (GF-GA) (all games) **Maximum of 2 goals per game differential, (D) Most goals scored, (E) Least against, (F) GF/GA, (G) Least penalty minutes
 - 1 referee per game.
 - LOCKER ROOMS: will be assigned to teams from the skate counter. Keys will be issued 30 minutes before scheduled game time. Keep the locker rooms clean. Teams are responsible for any damages done to the facility.
- 7. ILLEGAL PLAYERS & TEAMS: If the tournament director determines that an illegal player has participated in the tournament, the player(s) shall be immediately removed from the tournament and the team using the ineligible player(s) will receive a 0-1 forfeit loss in each of the games the illegal player(s) participated in. Illegal players are any participants that:
 - Participate in a division below their skill level
 - Participate on two team rosters
 - Are under 18 years of age

THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE ANY DECISIONS REGARDING THE TOURNAMENT RULES, FORMAT AND ANY OTHER ISSUES FOR THE OVERALL GOOD OF THE EVENT. IN ALL CASES, THIS DECISION WILL BE FINAL.
